_____ I understand that payment for Camps/Intensives/Adult Classes are due *at the time of registering*. You may request a payment plan, but payment must be complete for the Camps/Intensives/Adult Classes by the start of the class(es) registered for.

_____ I understand that Camps/Intensives/Adult Classes need a minimum of 6 people to be held. Camps/Intensives/Adult Classes with less than 6 are subject to cancellation within 48 hours via your email on file. SPAA will issue refunds/credits only for this reason.

_____ I understand that there are *no refunds* for Camps/Intensives/Adult Classes unless SPAA has cancelled.

_____ \$15 late fees apply for payments not received by the first day of Camps/Intensives/Adult Classes.

_____ To ensure a positive learning environment and timely progression of your dancer, the teacher and director reserve the right to properly place your dancer in the appropriate level of summer camp or intensive.

_____ Our studios have viewing windows for you to observe the classes being taught. If you notice your dancer or other dancers getting heavily distracted by you watching, please walk away for a couple of minutes. Please do not tap on the windows or move the furniture to see into the studio. Children who are not taking class need to be supervised at all times. This includes the lobby, restrooms, break room, and outdoor areas. Please do not allow children to climb or color on furniture or walls. Empty studios are not playrooms. Please do not run in the lobby!

_____ Please try your best to get your dancer to their class on time. If they are late, please have them put on their shoes in the lobby before entering the classroom for less distraction. Do not wear dance shoes outside. Students must be fully dressed with proper outdoor clothing when entering or exiting the building. If you are going to be more than ten minutes late picking up your dancer, please contact the front desk.

_____ SPAA is located in a downtown setting. I understand where the SPAA parking lot is located and where additional public parking is also located. I understand that my dancer(s) are not supervised by SPAA staff once they have exited SPAA. No student under the age of 12 is permitted to leave the building without an adult.

SUMMER CAMPS AND INTENSIVES 2026 SCHEDULE

Princess and Prince Summer Camp for ages 3-5: Be a princess or prince each day! Camp includes a daily ballet class, arts and crafts, choreography, and a snack break (please bring one from home). On the final day, families are invited to a short presentation from 12:00–12:30pm. Dancers should wear a leotard, tights, and ballet shoes with hair in a ponytail. Boys may wear black shorts and a white T-shirt. For summer camps only, if these items are not available, dancers may wear comfortable clothing with ballet shoes. **Dancers must be potty trained.*

- June 15-19, 2026 10:00am-12:30pm \$175
- July 20-24, 2026 10:00am-12:30pm \$175

Summer Dance Camp for ages 6-8: Each day includes ballet, jazz, choreography, and a snack break (please bring one from home). On the final day, families are invited to a short presentation from 4:00–4:15pm. Dancers should wear a leotard, tights, ballet shoes, and jazz shoes. Boys may wear black shorts and a white T-shirt. For summer camps only, if these items are not available, dancers may wear comfortable clothing with ballet and jazz shoes.

- June 8-12, 2026 1:30pm-4:00pm \$200
- July 13-17, 2026 1:30pm-4:00pm \$200

Rising Star Intensive for ages 8-12: Each day, dancers will take ballet plus jazz, modern, and hip hop throughout the week. There will be a daily snack break (please bring a snack from home). Dancers should wear a leotard, tights, ballet shoes, jazz shoes (if they have them), and tennis shoes, with hair in a bun or ponytail. Jazz pants or shorts may be packed for jazz, modern, and hip hop. On the final day, families are invited to a short presentation from 4:00–4:30pm. **This intensive is required for Southern Ballet Theatre Demi Apprentices and highly recommended for Ballet III and Pre-Pointe dancers. Demi Apprentices may choose one or both weeks.*

Teen Dance Camp for ages 11 and up: Our Teen Dance Camp is perfect for teens with less than two years of dance experience who want to continue their training. Each day includes ballet, jazz, choreography, and a snack break (please bring from home). On the final day, families are invited to a short presentation from 4:00–4:15pm. Dancers should wear a leotard, tights, ballet shoes, and jazz shoes. For summer camps only, if these items are not available, dancers may wear comfortable clothing with ballet and jazz shoes.

Hip Hop Camp for ages 6-15 (camp will be divided by age): Each day includes hip hop, choreography, and a snack break (please bring one from home). On the final day, families are invited to a short presentation from 12:45–1:00pm. Dancers should wear comfortable athletic clothing with clean tennis shoes.

Dress code: Any color/style leotard with convertible tights. Males may wear black shorts and a white T-shirt. Dance experience is required.*

| PARKING FOR THE STUDIO |
